## Important Dates and Due Dates

### November 10, 2016

- Attend the open house from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM
- Attend one of the information presentations in the auditorium at 6:00PM or 7:00PM
- Visit our school website [www.satec.on.ca](http://www.satec.on.ca) for information and to read the **Frequently Asked Questions** section about the admissions process

### November 25, 2016

- Notify your intent to apply and to register for the **Entrance Test** by completing the online application form found in the Admissions page of the school website.
- If you have an IEP or ESL consideration, submit official documentation to SATEC by November 25, 2016. This must be done by 4:00 PM to ensure arrangements for accommodations are made.

### December 2, 2016

- **Entrance Test** will take place from 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM
- The following items/documents are required to write the Entrance Test:
  - a. Out-of-area students must submit the completed (and signed) Optional Attendance Application Form (this form is available from Grade 8 Guidance Counsellors and also the TDSB website)
  - b. Grade 7 June Report Card
  - c. Trillium Student Index Card
  - d. \$15 administration fee (cash only, **exact change**, non-refundable). If there is difficulty paying this fee, then please see a SATEC administrator prior to the testing day.
  - e. Pencil, eraser, pen, and scientific calculator (non-programmable, non-graphing)

### By February 14, 2017 \*

- Parents, guardians and elementary schools will be mailed a **Conditional Offer of Acceptance** or non-acceptance.

### By February 27, 2017 \*

- Parents and guardians must confirm the conditional offer of acceptance by:
